East Ridge High School is a comprehensive four-year public high school located in Woodbury, MN, which was recently named the 11th top place to live in Money Magazine. East Ridge serves students in the communities of Woodbury, Cottage Grove, Newport and St. Paul Park. High school classes are scheduled in a six-period day with three trimesters (12 weeks) in each grading period.

About the Community:

ERHS is part of the South Washington County School District, ISD #833. The district includes the communities of Cottage Grove, St. Paul Park, Newport, Woodbury, Grey Cloud Island and Afton, encompassing an area of 84 square miles. The population of the district is approximately 94,000 people, including 18,200 students who attend district schools.

10.5% of the student population at ERHS participate in the Free/Reduced Lunch Program.

In District 833, there are three high schools, one alternative high school, four middle schools and 15 elementary schools.

Grading and Ranking Procedures

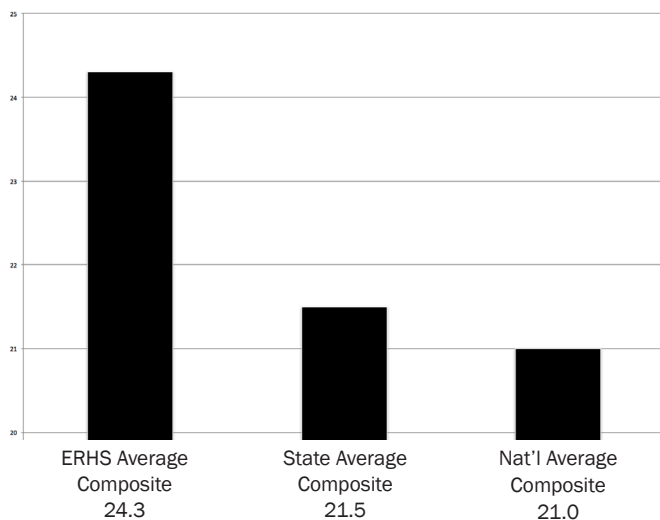
GPA is based on marks earned in grades 9-12. All courses for which the student receives a grade A - F are included in the GPA. Pass grades are not included in the GPA, but do count for graduation credit (a max. of two credits per year may be taken with the pass/no credit option).

Grades for Advanced Placement, Project Lead the Way, College-in-the-School, and University of Minnesota Talented Youth Math Program (UMTYMP) will receive a weighted grade using a 1.2 multiplier. For example, an A in a weighted course would be equal to a 4.8 towards the students GPA.

Advanced Placement Test Results

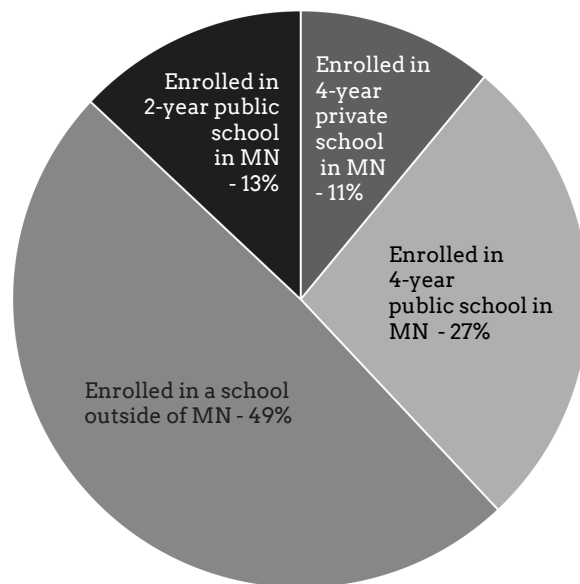
- During the 2016-17 school year, 1,100 AP exams were taken.
