

## Washington County Public Health & Environment 2016 IMMUNIZATION CLINICS– July through December

Low cost immunizations (vaccinations) are available through the Minnesota Vaccines for Children (MnVFC) Program. Only people who meet MnVFC eligibility guidelines can get MnVFC vaccine. There is a \$12 administration fee for each MnVFC immunization, but no one who qualifies for MnVFC immunizations will be turned away if they are unable to pay the cost.

Persons who have private insurance or are on a Minnesota Health Care Program that covers immunizations must receive immunizations from their private medical provider.

### MnVFC Eligibility Guidelines

- Children (18 years of age and younger) who **do not** have health insurance
- Children on a Minnesota Health Care Program - MA, MinnesotaCare, or PMAP
- Children who are American Indian or Alaskan Native
- Children who have health insurance that does not cover vaccines
- Adults (19 and older) may qualify for some immunizations; call 651-430-6655 for eligibility guidelines

If you have questions about the reduced fee immunization eligibility or need assistance due to disability or language barrier, please call 651-430-6655 (TTY 651-430-6246). Immunization services given at public clinics should not be substituted for your child's usual well-child visit with his or her physician. **All minors younger than age 18 years must be accompanied by their parent or legal guardian.**

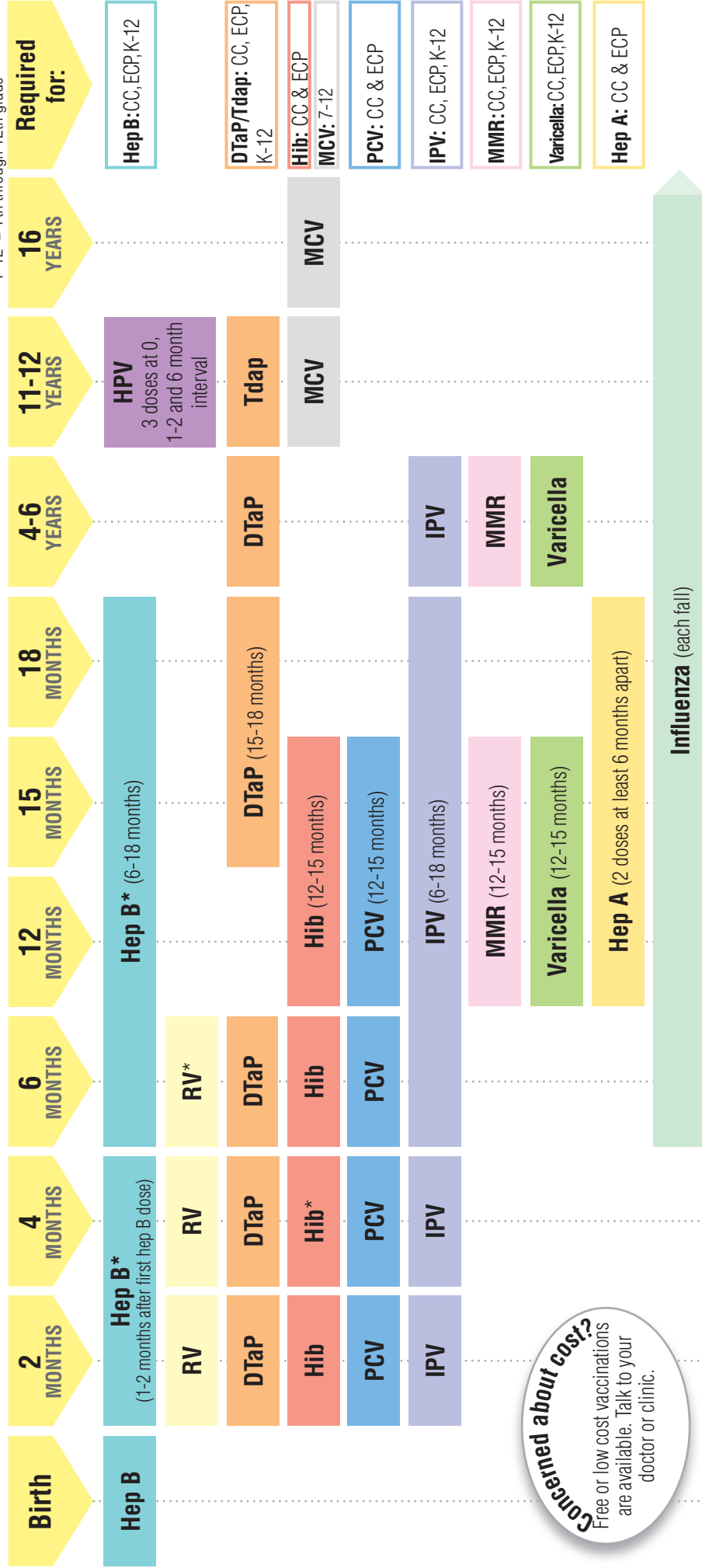

# When to Get Vaccines Birth to 16 Years

CC = Child care  
ECP = Early Childhood Programs  
K-12 = Kindergarten through 12th grade  
7-12 = 7th through 12th grade



**Concerned about costs?**  
Free or low cost vaccinations are available. Talk to your doctor or clinic.

It's not too late! If your child has fallen behind on their vaccinations, talk to your doctor or clinic to catch them up.

Minnesota law requires written proof of certain vaccinations for children in child care, early childhood programs, and school. However, if a child has a medical reason or if his/her parents are conscientiously opposed to any or all of the vaccinations, a legal exemption is available.

**Children with certain medical conditions may need additional vaccines** (e.g., pneumococcal or meningococcal). Talk to your doctor or clinic.

**Pregnant?** Protect yourself and your baby from whooping cough, get a Tdap vaccination between 27 and 36 weeks gestation. Talk to your doctor.

\*The **number of doses** depends on the product your doctor uses.

Key to vaccine abbreviations

DTaP/Tdap=diphtheria, pertussis, tetanus	Hib = <i>Haemophilus influenzae</i> type b
Hep B=hepatitis B	IPV=polio
MMR= measles, mumps, rubella	PCV= pneumococcal
	RV=rotavirus
