102.1 DIVERSITY, EQUITY AND INCLUSION

I. PURPOSE

South Washington County Schools recognizes the value of sustaining and advancing a safe and welcoming learning environment, and thus, strives to treat both employees and students with respect and dignity.

II. GENERAL STATEMENT OF POLICY

The district strives to treat employees and students fairly with regards to all procedures and choices and to provide ample opportunities to achieve their full potential. The achievement of equality of opportunity is central to the mission as a public education institution and as an employer. The district's commitment is not simply to meeting statutory requirements, but endeavors to be a leader in the commitment to diversity, equity and inclusion.
