



713.1 GATE RECEIPTS AND ADMISSIONS

I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to establish admission fees for certain athletic/activity events in the school district.

II. GENERAL STATEMENT OF POLICY

It is the policy of this school district that admissions fees will be established by administration and the district finance department.

III. EVENTS

A. Athletic Events

1. High School
 - There will be an admission charge for all athletic events (except cross country, tennis, adaptive soccer, Nordic skiing, downhill skiing, golf, baseball, softball, track if not section or conference).
2. Middle School
 - It is the practice of the district not to charge admission to middle school athletic events, unless it is tournament play.
3. District athletic passes (good for one school year) may be purchased for athletic events at the High Schools. Elementary students are free if a parent/guardian purchases a district athletic pass. (Note: these passes are NOT good for hockey and section or conference playoff games/events.)
4. Senior citizens, 60 years or older with proper identification, will receive free admission to all district athletic events, except hockey and section or conference playoff games/events.
5. District employees will be admitted free to all district athletic events provided they show their district picture identification badge. This badge will admit the employee only and will not be transferable. (Note: these badges are NOT good for hockey and section or conference playoff games/events.)

B. Non-Athletic Events – contact specific schools to ask if there are admission costs attached to these events. District employees will be admitted free to all district non-athletic events provided they show their district picture identification badge. This badge will admit the employee only and will not be transferable.

5. Middle School Plays
