



Free Breakfast and Lunch Provided to Students at No cost

South Washington County Schools

The United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) has approved **South Washington County Schools to provide free breakfast and lunch for all enrolled students**. Meals purchased between Sept. 8-11 will be credited back to each student's account by the end of September. **Free meals will be provided until federal funding runs out.**

How to receive free school meals



During breakfast and lunch at school, students will use their meal barcode at checkout. The meal will be automatically discounted.



At curbside meal pick-up sites, meals will automatically be discounted with the use of a student barcode at checkout. Schedules and locations for curbside meal pick-up can be found online at sowashco.org/nutrition.

When federal funding runs out, meals may return to being charged based on free or reduced-priced meal qualifications. If you qualify for free or reduced-priced meals, please be sure to fill out the application on our website, sowashco.org/nutrition, in preparation for when regular prices return.



Student barcodes will still be required in school and at curbside pick-up. This barcode can be found online in your SchoolCafé account.
