

What to do After a Positive COVID-19 Test



Call your child(ren)'s school attendance line to inform of positive COVID-19 test result.



Stay home for 10 days if you test positive. Others exposed should stay home for 14 days.



Answer your phone when the school nurse calls for any additional information

If ANY member of your family that lives in your house tests positive for COVID-19:

- Person who tests positive needs to isolate at home for at least 10 days.
- Other family members will need to quarantine at home for at least 14 days after last contact with positive individual.

Attendance Guidelines



Student at Home, but NOT Sick: Student at Home and Sick:

Students will participate in distance learning if:

- Asked to stay home for 14 days for a COVID-19 related reason
- If asked to stay home while waiting for COVID-19 test results
- If sent home due to a sibling being required to stay home for a COVID-19 reason
- If family decides to keep their child home for a non-required quarantine



An excused absence will be received if:

- Student has signs and symptoms of COVID-19 and they are sent home
- A student tests positive for COVID-19

Students will need to make up missed assignments or complete alternative assignments determined by teacher after they recover.
