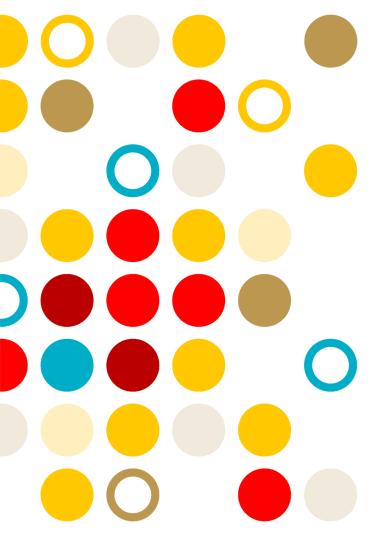
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


What is World's Best Workforce?

Minnesota statute requires every school district to develop goals in prescribed areas and to report on those goals annually.

World's Best Workforce Requirements

- Annual report and presentation
- District advisory committee
- Equitable access to excellent and diverse educators
- Five goals and tracking of progress



District Data and Assessment Committee (DDAC)

- Purpose: To provide recommendations regarding assessment practices
- 18 members, including parents, school and district staff members, and a school board member
- Met three times in school year 2020-21
- Examples of meeting topics
 - School improvement process
 - Balanced assessment systems
 - 2021 Minnesota Comprehensive Assessments (MCA) results and use

Equitable Access to Excellent and Diverse Teachers



Among SoWashCo students:

- 36% identify as Black, Indigenous, or a Person of Color
- 15% receive free or reduced price lunch



Among SoWashCo teachers:

- 96% have more than three years of experience
- 99% are licensed in the area they teach, a 1:17 ratio of students to licensed teachers
- 76% have earned a master's degree or higher
- 5% identify as Black, Indigenous, or a Person of Color


- Changes in learning environments

Fall proficiency in letter sounds & identification





Goal 2: All students in third grade achieving grade-level proficiency




MCA-III Reading proficiency among third grade students



The MCA-III assessments were not administered in SY 2019-20. Additionally, there was a 19% drop in students taking the MCA-III in SY 2020-21.


Goal 3: Close achievement gaps between student groups






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




Goal 4: All students career and college-ready by graduation



ACT Reading Benchmark of 22




A goal was not identified for the class of 2021. The ACT was rescheduled from April 2020 to October 2020 and over 500 students did not take the test likely due to post-secondary institutions waiving test requirements for admission.
