### **Current Enrollment Baselines**

- Grey Cloud, Pine Hill and Red Rock Elementary Schools are over 95% utilized; with Bailey Elementary at at 91%
- Six elementary schools have over 30% open seats (Armstrong, Crestview, Cottage Grove, Hillside, Newsport and Woodbury Elementary Schools)
- Lake Middle School, Oltman Middle School and Woodbury Middle Schools are over 95% utilized; overall middle school deficit in 2024-25
- East Ridge High School 115% utilization
- Woodbury High School 102% utilization
- Park High School 96% utilization
- Deficit of more than over 200 high school seats

#### Elementary: DistrictWide Deficit of 600 Seats by Year 2030, with a 3100 Seat Shortage by 2040

Despite Concentrated Growth, 4 Schools Remain 70% Occupancy Into the 10- and 20-Year Projections

Bailey, Grey Cloud, Pine Hill, and Red Rock in Immediate Danger of Exceeding Capacity

Cottage Grove ES and Liberty Ridge Likely to Follow Suit Shortly

#### <u>Middle School</u>: DistrictWide Deficit of 1100 Seats by Year 2030, with a 1500 Seat Shortage by Year 2040

Oltman Likely to Exceed Capacity Next Year, with Lake Following the Year After

Cottage Grove MS will be Slower to Grow, but is Anticipated to Exceed Capacity by 2027

Woodbury MS is Expected to Hover Near Capacity for the Foreseeable Future

#### <u>High Schools</u>: DistrictWide Deficit of 1100 Seats by Year 2030, with a 2000 Seat Shortage by Year 2040

Existing Deficit of Over 200 High School Seats with East Ridge Operating at 115% Today

East Ridge Expected to Experience a Shortage of Nearly 900 Seats by 2030

Park and Woodbury High Schools Expected to Near a 200 Seat Shortage Each by 2030

<u>Operations Sites</u>: Program Center, Service Center, and Transportation are Significantly Lacking Facilities

<u>Realities</u>: Land is Becoming Scarce, It Takes TIME to Build, Some Sites are Limited in the Constr<mark>uction of Additions</mark>

**Dec. 2021** Explore financing options (potential bond referendum)

**Feb. 2022** Conduct community and taxpayer survey

March 2022 Final proposal goes to the school board

June 2022 Begin sharing bond referendum information

Aug. 9, 2022 Special election for bond referendum
