## Long-Range Facility Plan Guiding Change Document



#### Results

- Utilize information from the demographic report and input from community and staff to create a 5-year facility plan that prioritizes the needs and takes into consideration the current economic conditions.
- The district may need to consider boundary changes and moving students in schools located outside the city where they live.
- Create a funding plan to address the costs of the 5-year Facility Plan, which will include Bonding, Lease Levies, and Long Term Facility Maintenance revenue.

#### **Unacceptable Means**

- SoWashCo Schools will not ignore the current economic conditions, input from community and staff, results of the community survey or the updated demographic report.
- SoWashCo Schools will not bring forth a plan that closes any elementary school.
- SoWashCo Schools will not bring multiple plans forward.



#### Long Range Facilities Plan Feedback


Following the August referendum vote, we gathered input and feedback from families, staff and community member to revise the facility plan.

- Dozens of listening sessions for staff and community to gather and document feedback.
- Community survey of 500 randomly selected homes in our school boundaries. Completed in December 2022
- Commissioned a new demographic study. Completed in January 2023.
- Set dates for three in-person community meetings and three meetings with parent advisory groups.
  - Our third community meeting is Tuesday, May 23 at East Ridge High School.



#### Long Range Facilities Plan Feedback

- Hosted two school bus tours and a lunch and learn event for elected and city officials.
- Have met with several business groups to discuss our new long-range facility plan
- Held three staff meeting sessions at each school to gather feedback and input
- Mailed Community Meeting postcard invitations to all district residents
- Began a new printed newsletter (will be quarterly) that will be mailed to all district residents. The first issue should arrive via mail this week.





## **Staff Feedback**


More than 925 staff members have completed a staff survey for presentation 3. We asked:

What would you add or remove from proposed Question 2?








Percentage of Staff Responses
